Financial report 2009 and financial planning 2010

With own funds (capital and reserves) of EUR 511,788.98 at the reporting date, the association has now as before a solid financial basis, since with the funds available the work of ECPC will be guaranteed in the next year even without the inflow of further sponsors' monies. Moreover, additional means will be available in the next few years for further projects as well as for the build-up of further human resources in the medium term.

Divergences from the budget 2009, with respect to revenue, were due to the fact that the receipts of sponsors' unrestricted grants substantially exceeded the budgeted estimations. Due to personnel changes in the Brussels ECPC office significantly lower personnel costs as well as rental costs for offices amounting to about 80,000 EUR resulted on the side of expenditures. At the same time, budgeted costs for projects to the amount of 25,000 EUR for the MAC project were not expended.

Expected interest earnings dropped cyclically much more significantly by 10,000 EUR. At the same time, there were exchange losses to the deposits kept in GBP. Moreover, higher costs arouse for receiving fiscal consultancy services relating to the altered regulatory framework for non-profit-organisations (ANBI) in the Netherlands.

Due to the above-mentioned factors, an unpredicted revenue surplus of EUR 90,824.69 resulted for 2009.

The drawing up of a budget for the oncoming business year guarantees that the forecast expenses will be kept within the scope of the revenue to be expected. With a possible decrease in revenue from sponsors' monies in the next business year, the surplus of 2009 would therefore partially shrink.

The non-profit-status (ANBI) from 2009 onwards as requested by ECPC has again been approved by the Dutch tax authorities.

Auditor's certificate

I have audited the annual account of the European Cancer Patient Coalition (ECPC) for the business year from January 1st to December 31st, 2009, consisting of the profit and loss account as well as the internal balance sheet on the basis of the accounting of said association. The accounting and preparation of the annual account in accordance with the statutory provisions and their interpretation by the IDW¹ expert opinion on the accounting: Accounts of associations (IDW RS HFA 14) and the supplementary provisions of the articles of the associations lie within the responsibility of the legal representatives of the respective association. It is my job to present an assessment of the annual account prepared on the basis of the association's accounting based on the audit conducted by me.

I conducted my audit with due regard to the IDW auditing standard "audit of associations" (IDW PS 750). In accordance with said standard, the audit shall be planned and conducted in a manner which allows to recognize, with sufficient certainty, inaccuracies and infringements significantly affecting the representation of the annual account. When determining the individual auditing measures, the knowledge of the activity and the economic and legal environment of the association as well as the expectations of possible faults are taken into account. During the audit, the effectiveness of the internal control system relating to accounts and proofs of the statements in the accounting and the annual account are predominantly judged on the basis of sample audits. The audit comprises the judgment of the account principles applied and of the essential assessments of the legal representatives. I believe that my audit provides a reasonably sound basis for my judgment.

According to my assessment which was formed on the basis of my insight obtained during the audit the annual account complies with the statutory provisions and their interpretation by IDW RS HFA 14 and the supplementary provisions of the articles of the association.

In compliance with generally accepted auditing standards the annual account determines as a whole a picture of the asset, financial and profit situation of the association as of December 31st, 2009, reflecting the actual situation.
