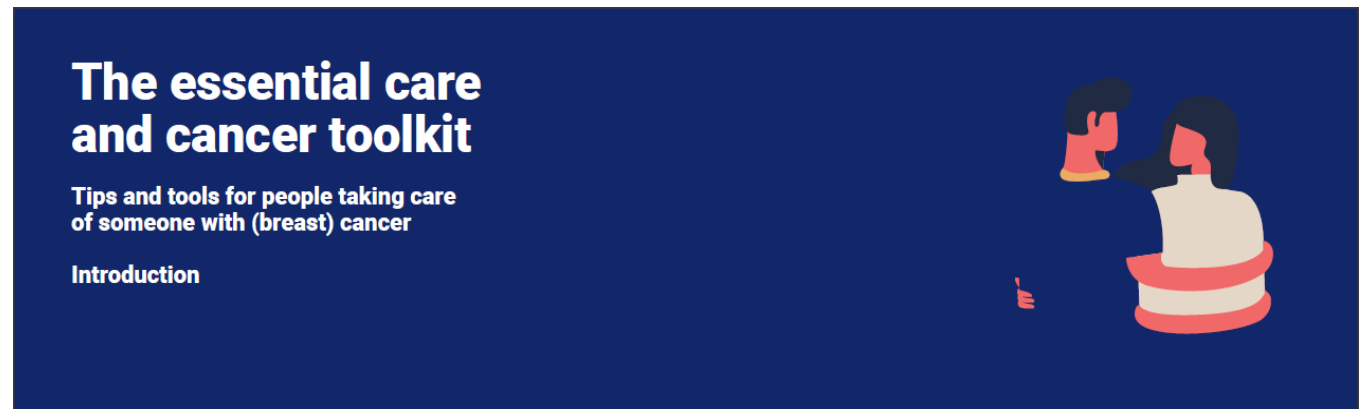

Why? From Caring to Cancer Caring

- Need for concrete support expressed by carers
- More and more people concerned/ little awareness
- Health and well-being of informal carers is at stake!
- Quality of care is at stake!
- Eurocarers' expertise is in supporting carers
- Eurocarers' commitment regarding chronic diseases



What for?

- Providing cancer carers with key information, tips and tools;
- Helping them take stock of the situation;
- Encourage them to evaluate and organise the support they may need.

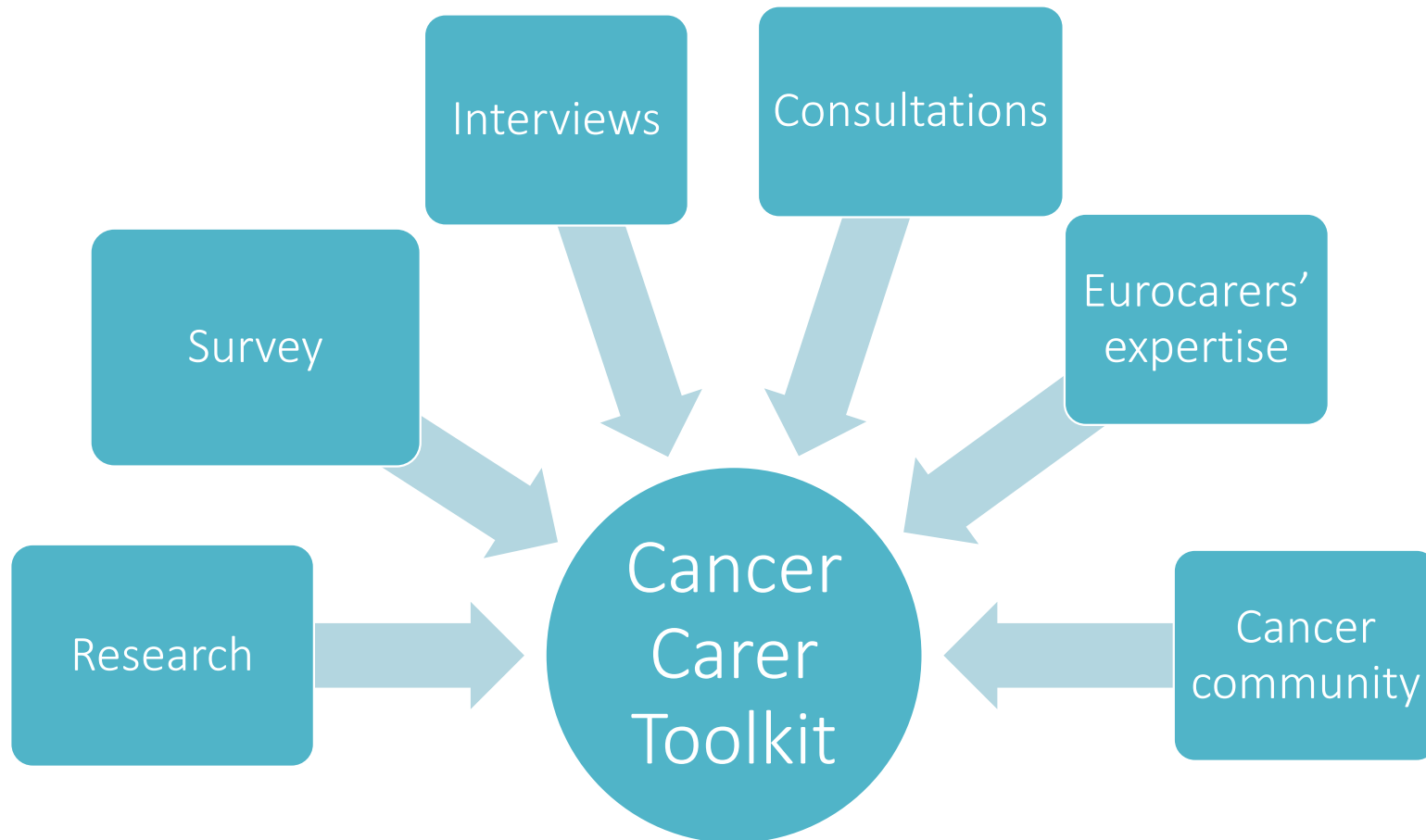
