What is the survey for?

This information will give us an in-depth and wide-reaching view of how cancer patients have been affected during this pandemic and allow us to continue to help support the lives of cancer patients during unprecedented times such as the current pandemic. In turn, with this information, we can:

- **confront policy-makers** and call for **quality and equal access** to treatment for cancer patients **in all countries under all circumstances**.
- see **how disrupted healthcare** correlates with **deteriorated treatment outcomes** and **increased death incidence** in the coming year.
- predict/identify **new advocacy, policy and research topics**
