2nd general assembling meeting of the LEGACy consortium



LEGACy held its 2nd annual meeting to discuss the progress of the project on 15th May 2020. The event which was initially scheduled to be hosted in Porto has been carried out virtually due to the mobility restrictions derived from COVID-19.

During the meeting, the progress of LEGACy, which is in its second year of development, was analyzed and the objectives achieved were reviewed, such as the recruitment situation of the centers, the fine-tuning of the protocols, the training plan, and dissemination activities. The work plan for this year was presented too. The consortium addressed the incidence of COVID-19 and developed the contingency and mitigation plan on how to proceed with the project.

The LEGACy project consortium established a contingency plan to adjust to the current situation. They developed a new strategy for the project adopting a telemedicine approach to be able to continue with studies and introduced protection measures for lab workers.
