ECPC is working on a project on the **right to be forgotten for cancer survivors**.

Today, about half of patients who are diagnosed with cancer will survive for 10 years or more. There are currently over 14 million cancer survivors in Europe and the proportion of people predicted to survive the diagnosis of cancer is increasing by around 3% per year. **Despite these increasing numbers, almost all EU countries lack adequate policies to ensure smooth reintegration of cancer survivors into social and professional life.**

Cancer survivors face a plethora of challenges to adjust and reintegrate as active members of society, yet even

decades of being cancer free, survivors face discrimination in access to financial services
