### Right To Be Forgotten Survey - deadline extension

Our survey about The Right To Be Forgotten has been extended until **11 May 2020**.

The Right To Be Forgotten is a legal provision **having the aim to avoid discrimination in accessing to financial instruments for cancer survivors**, and already endorsed by some EU member states as **France, Belgium and Luxembourg**. Since February 2020, **ECPC is working on a legal project on The Right To Be Forgotten for cancer survivors to assess this kind of discrimination, and promoting further actions at the EU level.**
