By Train: **IC S19** to *Brussels-Luxembourg* (every 30 mins)



By Bus: take STIB **Airport Line** (Brussels City) and stop at *Luxembourg*



By Taxi: **Taxis Verts** +32 23494949 (€29.10 - €33.50, but prices vary)



Brussels South Charleroi Airport



1) Take **flibco.com** bus to *Brussels-Midi* (cheaper fares if booked online)



2) Head to Rue de France and walk for 400 m to *Brussels-Midi*

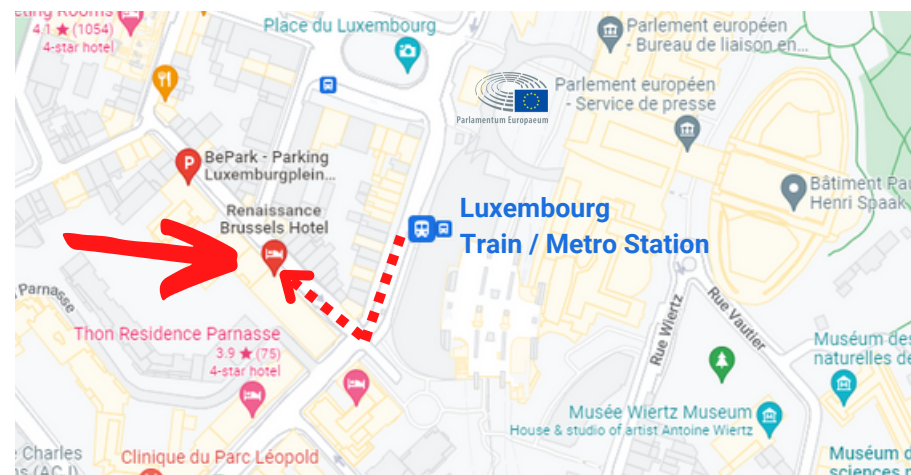
3) Take **S8 train** and stop at *Brussels-Luxembourg*



By Taxi: **Door2Gate by flibco.com** (starting from €29.99, online booking)

Brussels-Luxembourg (nearest train / metro station)

- 1) Head west on Place du Luxembourg
- 2) Turn left onto Rue d'Arlon
- 3) Turn left onto Rue du Parnasse



Brussels-Midi

- 1) Take **Metro Line 2 or 6 (Elisabeth)** and stop at *Trône*
- 2) Walk from Avenue des Arts to Rue du Luxembourg
- 3) After 400 m turn right onto Rue Marie de Brougogne
- 4) Turn left to Rue du Parnasse (110 m)



Brussels-Central

- 1) Take **Metro line 38 (Héros)** and stop at *Luxembourg*
- 2) See Brussels-Luxembourg for further instructions



Brussels-North

- 1) Take **S8 train** and stop at *Luxembourg*
- 2) See Brussels-Luxembourg for further instructions

Foreign currencies

Euro (€) is Belgium's currency. If you need to exchange your local currency with euro, bear in mind exchange rates and fees might vary according to the service and the time of the day.

For real-time rates, check <https://wise.com/gb/currency-converter>

Currency bureaux DME Change, Ria, and Eurogold are located in the city centre. Zaventem and Charleroi airports also offer exchange services.

If using an ATM, it is commonly recommended to choose to be charged in Euro to avoid an extra fee for the conversion service.

COVID-related measures

1 Before your departure

Make sure you check:

- www.info-coronavirus.be/en/travels/
- reopen.europa.eu (make sure you select Belgium)
- www.commissioner.brussels/en/updates-covid-19
- rules and recommendations of your home country

Check if you are required to:

- fill out the **Passenger Locator Form**
- have proof of vaccination, recovery, or negative molecular/antigenic test

A valid 'EU Digital COVID Certificate', any other accepted certificate (check before departing), or a test taken prior to flight might constitute a proof.

2 When in Brussels

Make sure you check info-coronavirus.be and follow the prescribed rules.

As a rule of thumb, when unsure, wear a mask and keep social distancing.
